All divisions will be offered twice, which means...double champions, double points and the classes award bonus points as well! A great year end point party!

The jumper classes will be challenging, technical and tricky but safe. The equitation courses will be held over a jumper style course.

All flat classes will be challenging and will put the riders through the gauntlet.

The Costume Contest: Each day a <u>\$1,000</u> <u>Costume class</u> will be offered thanks to <u>Littleton Equine</u> <u>Medical Clinic with Fox Hill Equestrian Center</u> and <u>Fox Creek Mobile Equine Outfitters with In Stride</u>, Inc.

The judging will be done by the judges (duh) and the tie breaking steward as the day progresses which means your costumes must be rideable. Equitation riders, formal attire has been waived but keep in mind that the judge must be able to see a riders position in order to judge it.

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Location & Directions 6000 Main Street, Littleton 80125 (use zip code for navigator)

From Santa Fe Drive turn west on Kelley Avenue, Cross two sets of railroad tracks and barn will be on the left. Kelley Avenue is 2.4 miles south of Titan road. Watch for the "Louviers" sign. (303-519-2538 for more detailed directions if needed). *Make sure to use the zip code when map questing.* If train tracks are occupied, go south to Airport Road, turn west and then take the first right (north) on Lavaun drive, and follow any branch to back to Kelley Avenue, turn left and proceed west to Fox Hill.

<u>Liability</u>

Fox Hill Equestrian Center and In Stride, Inc will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it will be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold harmless the show and its management for any loss or accident to their animals or equipment. The show will not be responsible for any articles of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, or stolen; and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to participants, spectators, employee or any other party. Any damage caused to Fox Hill Equestrian property will be billed to the offending party. This includes exposure to infectious diseases. Anyone not following the Covid Protocol will be asked to leave the facility and no refund will be given.

Under Colorado Law, an equine professional is not liable for injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Section 13-21-119 Colorado Revised Statutes.

Dogs:

Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES. At no time should any dog be in the arena or its entrance. Clean up after your dog.

Footing & Rings

All arenas consist of arena grade sand and arena sand and fiber/rubber. The open field is also available for schooling and lunging. Fox Hill Equestrian Center is located in a river valley and has naturally sandy footing. Lunging permitted in the round pen to the south of the indoor or the indoor when not in use. Riders take precedence over lunging at all time. No lunging in any outdoor rings.

Numbers:

Each entrant must wear their assigned number clearly displayed and may be disqualified without it. Please return all numbers to the show office upon completion of the competition.

Awards / Championships/Payouts

- All classes- prize for 1st, ribbons through 6th, unless stated otherwise.
- Hunter Championships and Reserves will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 8.2C-D. Jumper Champion and Reserve Champion shall be awarded according to CHJA Rule 9.1C. Equitation

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Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 10.1C-D.

• Any classes offering money must have 6 entries to pay. Award money will be applied to any show fees. Any remainder will be issued a check. Riders entered in any class must ride in at least 1 other division class to be eligible for .

Changes and Cancellations

Show Management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to return any fees before or during the show without liability. Further, Show Management reserves the right to do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries, including capping entries. If there are less than 6 entries in a division, the division may be cancelled or combined, payouts will not occur. If entry numbers are too excessive prior to closing date for the schedule/facility to accommodate,

Schooling/Warm up

Management/course designer reserves the right to change any jump or course post-schooling and prior to the start of show.

Schooling will be monitored by the Steward, Gate Person, and staff of Fox Hill for safety and numbers will be limited. Dangerous riders may be excused from the ring. Some jumps may be off limits to schooling. Schooling is open 1.5 hours prior to start of the first ring start time and will close 30 min before start time.

Returned checks

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full by cash or certified funds.

<u>Stabling</u>

Stall fees are \$50 per day. We have limited stalls. For stall reservations and arrival arrangements you must call Liz Tuttle at 303-520-4410. <u>Marking it on the entry</u> does not reserve a stall, you must contact Liz!

Stall reservations without completed entries will be released to the next person on the wait list on the Sunday Oct 20th closing date. Stalls are available from Friday through Sunday.

Fees Enter if you dare

- Regular classes- \$35/class
- Ticketed Schooling \$35
- EMT fee \$20 per rider
- Office Fee \$30 per number issued
- \$20 grounds fee to all non-stabled horses
- Stalls \$50 per day
 - \$25 after entry deadline. Late entries are not guaranteed. Call to check if we are accepting entries after 9 p.m Sunday Oct 20th.
- <u>NO DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED</u>

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- <u>Cash or checks only, sorry, limited wifi...</u>
 Non-showing horses must pay EMT, Office and a stable/grounds fee and are only accepted on a space available basis. Anyone violating this will be fined \$110 per non-compliance.
 - Anyone ejected from the show due to noncompliance with our policies will not receive a refund.

***Entries must be complete for acceptance, meaning classes, signatures and Coggins. Any entries lacking these items will be placed at the bottom of the list. Entries are first come, first served and not guaranteed. You will receive an acceptance email if your entry is received and complete. Once we are at capacity, we will be closing entries and starting a wait list, even if it is prior to the closing date.

Any entry received after 9 p.m on the closing date of Sunday October 20th will be accepted only on a space available basis and will be assessed a \$25 late entry fee.

Scratches & Refunds

No charges will be applied to entries scratched prior to the closing date or if your spot can be filled from the waiting list. Any entry scratched after the number has been picked up will forfeit the Office fee of \$30.

Class Specifications

<u>Warm-up</u>

Warm-up is open to all horses and ponies entered in the show. Fences will match currently running division heights. Courses may be changed during the show. Warm-up will be closed during flat and other specified classes.

Jumper warm up is judged as a blue ribbon clear round.

Regulations and information

- Back-to-back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- "No- judges" will be allowed at the regular class fee with management approval only.
- Any division age splits, or combinations will be determined by entry numbers the preceding evening at the conclusion of the show day. We will not split based on same day adds...no exceptions.
- All warm up classes must be ridden before the division classes. Warm ups are allowed prior to, but not during the medal classes.
- ASTM Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Fox Hill Equestrian Center property.

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- Only one horse allowed per entry form.
- Paddock Master (gate) has control and jurisdiction of schooling and the ring. <u>Rudeness or non-</u><u>compliance will not be tolerated</u>. Entry to the show will be denied to anyone who does not follow this.
- A one-minute gate and/or a posted order-of-go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show.
- Fox Hill is a NON-SMOKING FACILITY. This is strictly enforced, please respect this! NO BUTTS ON THE GROUND PLEASE!
- All competitors are requested to respect the generosity and use of the facility and to please help KEEP IT CLEAN! Please pay attention to all signs and follow all posted rules and recommendations.

• There is no penalty for scratching or changing your entry so send your entries early to avoid the nonnegotiable late fee. We can only adjust classes for age division splits if we have entries in a timely fashion complete with classes and ages.

Health Requirements-

All horses must present proof of a negative Coggins Test dated within 1 year to the show secretary to <u>be included</u> <u>with your entry</u>. All horses must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza and EHV-1 & 4. Email certificates to: **Showentry@instrideinc.com**. We can keep certificates on file for the season if the paperwork is valid for the duration of the season.

We reserve the right to add additional requirements in the event of any local disease outbreaks that would necessitate a health certificate or health check at the gate. Our best defense against disease spread is individual responsibility (both human and horse). Do not bring any animal to a public outing if it has diarrhea, a fever, mucosal sores, or viscous nasal discharge. Take your horses temperature before you leave home. Thia applies to humans as well as horses... if you are sick stay home and take care of yourself! :)


